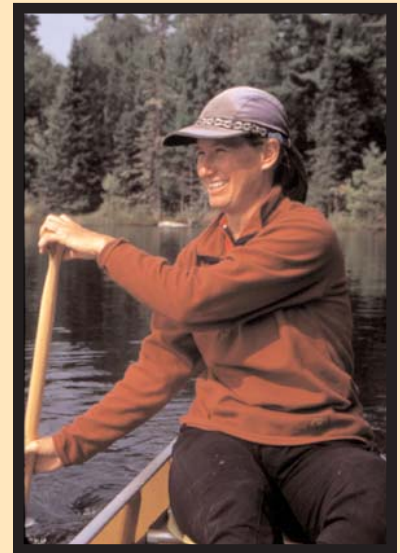

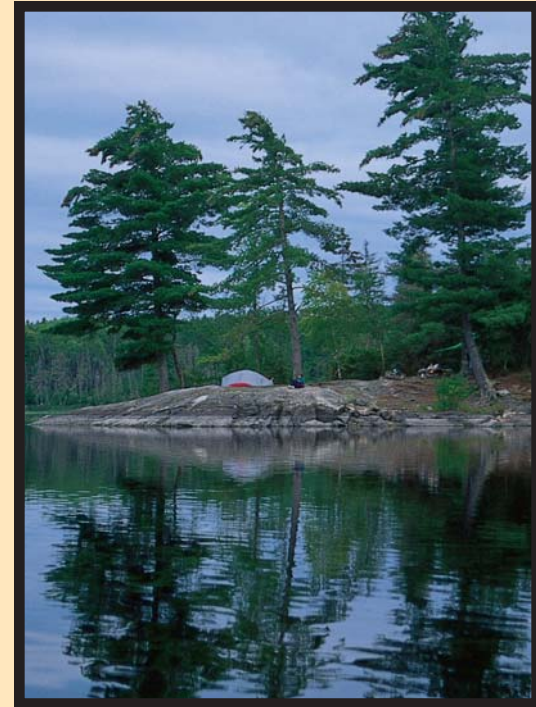

This is an advantage to parties who wish to get deep into the wilderness areas, but have limited vacation time. It maybe an option for seniors or persons who cannot or do not want to paddle long distances, but would like to have access to more remote areas. Towing is available for specific wilderness routes.*

If you forget something important for your canoe trip, our retail store stocks a wide supply of camping equipment, outdoor clothing and footwear to meet your needs.

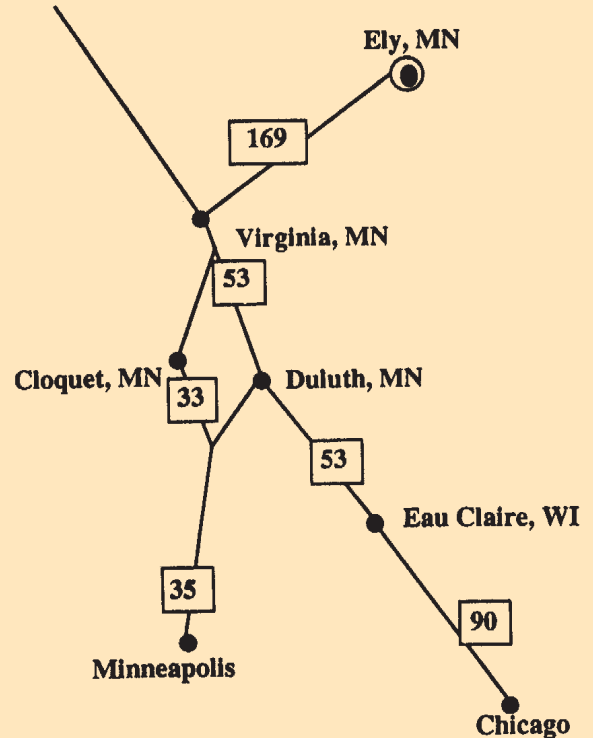

ACCESS TO THE WILDERNESS IS EASIER THAN YOU THINK...

Ely, Minnesota is one of America's northern frontiers, within a hike or short paddle of the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness (BWCAW) that separates the United States and Canada. Apart from its convenient proximity to entry points for the Boundary Waters, the Ely area boasts numerous historic and cultural attractions. Among these are the International Wolf Center and the Dorothy Molter Memorial Museum. Ely's restaurants, art galleries and unique shops provide pleasant diversions, as do two golf courses, hiking, biking and cross-country ski trails.

Ely is easy to reach. We can arrange van service to Ely from the airports in Minneapolis, Duluth, Hibbing or Ely. The Ely Airport has a 5,500-foot blacktop runway, operates on VFR plus has complete administrative and aircraft services with plenty of tie-downs. Scheduled flights to Ely via Northwest Airlinks are also available from May - September (subject to change). If you're driving, it is a pleasant and scenic drive over good roads.
